LIHUE AIRPORT

Nicknamed the “Garden Island,” Kauai’s stunning natural beauty includes the rugged Na Pali Coast and the massive Waimea Canyon, known as “The Grand Canyon of the Pacific.” LIH Airport (LIH) is Kauai’s primary airport and entry point, serving more than 2.8 Million passengers with 132,000+ takeoffs and landings each year.
